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Polished concrete was an obvious choice for the flooring. Not only is it practical as a garage floor but temperature-wise, it functions very well, keeping the space cool in the summer and warm in the winter thanks to in-slab heat. Along the back wall is the minimalist kitchen which consists of a workbench, drawers for storage and a big limestone sink.



A steel bridge leads to the second-floor loft, with the industrial feel of the glass and metal contrasting with the organic warmth of the wood.



Since Chernoff does most of the cooking outdoors on a large grill, there was little need for an elaborate kitchen. Plus she didn't want a kitchen to dominate the look of the space, so the appliances — a two-burner stove, dishwasher, fridge and convection/microwave oven — are discreetly placed in a wooden armoire.
